



ARKANSAS CONSERVATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (CIP)

Centerpoint Energy will offer CIP rebates to encourage the purchase and installation of more efficient natural gas appliances. The rebates for the qualified appliances are designed to offset a portion of the incremental cost of purchasing and installing a qualified higher AFUE natural gas appliance. This program is intended to be applied to gas to gas appliances, meaning it will only apply to switching from a lower efficiency natural gas appliance to a higher efficiency natural gas appliance or new construction. In the event that an existing residence decides to install a new, higher efficiency hot water tank or heating unit, the customer must be switching natural gas appliances. We are not able to provide these rebates to customers that are switching from electric or propane appliances to natural gas appliances. We are not allowed to "FUEL SWITCH".

CIP in effect as of January 1, 2010. We are currently designing a rebate form that will be available on our website. CNP is hopeful to have this form available by June 1, 2010.

In order to receive the rebates, the consumer must fill out a rebate form. For the time being, the customer can collect the necessary data until the forms have been added to our website.

GOVERNMENT REBATES:

Arkansas residents who replace an existing appliance with a new ENERGY STAR appliance purchased on or after March 15, 2010 are eligible to apply for the rebate.

Effective January 1, 2010, CenterPoint Energy will offer rebates up to \$300 for qualifying residential high-efficiency furnaces. HVAC dealers also receive a \$50 incentive for each qualifying heating system processed.

Boiler Reset Controls		Up to \$150 per control system, not to exceed equipment cost
Boiler Cut Out Controls		Up to \$150 per control system, not to exceed equipment cost
Boiler Vent Damper		Up to \$250 per boiler, not to exceed 25% of equipment cost
